Object of the game is to take out a tiny red dot. It's judged "touch and go" which means all you have to do is touch the dot. Ties are shot off, taking out the dot trumps a touch. There'll be both \$3 meat rounds and \$5 money rounds. Prizes for meat rounds are turkeys hams and meat packs. Money rounds pay 75% of the total entries per round. Shells are provided. If you don't have a gun there's always one to borrow. Come and shoot or just eat and mingle! The club will open at 4:30, shooting begins at 6pm. We usually shoot 10 matches so you can jump in anytime!
