FAMILY OUTDOOR SPORTING DAY - Saturday, September 20th

Formerly called Youth Day! We changed the name for several reasons, most importantly because we want this to be a family event. While it's aimed at kids we've learned that it's not just kids that enjoy participating! We had several 'moms' last year who had their first experience with shooting sports and thoroughly enjoyed themselves. Past problems with kids being dropped off and running amuck is not a good situation, especially when the event involves firearms. So why not make it a family event? We have great sponsorship this year with \$250 from the Heart of Ohio Chapter of the NWTF and \$200 from the Delaware Fish & Game Club. VFW 3313 in Marion has donated \$200 to sponsor the free lunch and Conway's BBQ in Marion is giving us a pretty good deal on pulled pork. We also received some kids stuff from the Sportsman's Den, ammo from Norton Sporting Goods, chips from Wyandot, ice from both Al's Country Market and Big P's Pit Stop. Something different we'll be doing this year is a Safety Orientation at the start of the event. It will be required for everyone who wants to try their hand at any of the hands-on shooting. While we strive to promote and generate interest in shooting sports, we want to stress safety first!

HANDS-ON ACTIVITIES: Rifle, Shotgun, Custom Shotgun, Archery, Pistol, Air Rifle, Reloading & Fishing. **DEMONSTRATIONS:** Alligators, snakes, force on force defense and the Marion Co. Sheriff's Canine Unit. Anyone wishing to help should be at the club about 7:30. We can never have too many people keeping an eye on things, safety is utmost! If you have the time, (even if its just an hour!) we can use everyone and anyone. Stations will be set up across the club grounds. We'll need help at the stations, monitoring the grounds, registration, setting up for lunch, etc. If you have anything at all to donate you can drop it off at the memberships office anytime.... food, goodie bag items, literature, gift certificates, door prizes, use your imagination!

ARCHERY – The club has purchased another 20 3D targets from the IBO. They were used at one event so they are in excellent condition and the price of \$2300 was about half of what they would have been new! Allen County Archers have been a great help to us. Not only have they helped at our events and brought in new shooters, but when they picked up their targets from the IBO (out of state!) they picked up ours as well and didn't ask for anything in return. We gave them \$100 to help cover fuel costs. We now have enough good targets to hold quality matches. The older targets that aren't suitable for matches are now set on the course for members to use at any time.

Saturday Sept. 20, 9am – noon archery will run concurrently with the Family Outdoor Sporting Day. Kids may shoot the course free. Adults - \$4 members, \$8 non-member, repeat course \$4. It's an excellent wooded course and L.A. Wheeler, Darlene Pacha, Roger and Chrys Rice work hard at running events and keeping the course and targets in good condition. It's an on going chore and we really appreciate their hard work! Plans are in place for indoor archery through the winter. If you're interested in helping with archery let us know!
